### **Minutes:**

- Kevin called the meeting to order at 7:14pm.
- Motion to approve September minutes by Lyle, Second DebbiLyn. All in favor.

- Some sports get almost all the Booster donations that have coaches that push it
- Football is suffering with Booster donations, coach is not asking
- Football and Boys' Water Polo have new coaches – fortunately they had a surplus in their accounts because the registration fees we've collected are low
- Glenn said we should add a link from Register My Athlete to the Booster Club site to pay the money – Mike will look into it
- If you Google Leland Booster Club the 2012 website comes up as one of the choices – Glenn will get rid of the old one
- The new website is paid for and the first phase is ready, we will sell apparel through it
- Mr. Munger gave Mike a great price for a new refrigerator

### **Booster Club Fundraising Events for 2016 (Kevin):**

- Nov. 7 Golf Tourney at the Almaden Country Club – continue to get the word out
- \$160 is the fee/includes lunch (no host bar), cap of 100 players, raffle & silent auction, wine baskets, Golf Foursomes, Leland paraphernalia, Ed has a donation request letter he can send out
- We need volunteers to check people in, to honor the prizes for a hole in one (Buick is giving a car away), sell raffle tickets – email Ed to get the number of people and timeframe – Renee to help organize volunteers
- Mike has a handful of Leland collared shirts
- We have about 54 people registered, we have to get 72 players
- Tony to send the flyer out to everyone, we need to post it on Social Media and tell friends
- We all need the donation letter as well
  - Golfers will show up at 10am, buy raffle tickets, buy alcohol, silent auction
- D2D date in March – date needs to be confirmed; lock in Kelly D. and other volunteers

### **Old Business (Kevin):**

- Possible projects (Banners, Sports “Team Room”, TRX System)
  - Mike is collecting all the banners – all will have them all and installed by the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Event early in May, Booster club should be on stand-by to help with this event
- New Refrigerator for the Snack Shack – we got a new one
- New Ice Machine (s) - \$4-6k for a new one – ask Mr. Munger and get a price – Mike would like a parent to help with this, Dom will help get a quote and look into this

### **New Business:**

- Mike to look for the Cheer banner that breaks apart when the Football players run through it
- We typically have about 10 kids go to CCS swim meet – swim suits are \$300 each
- We have outstanding bills from swim team, based on last year’s donations the funds will cover the bills. Mike asked the Booster club to loan the Swim Team the money to pay the bills,
- Kevin made a motion not to exceed \$6,500 to loan the Swim Team to pay their outstanding bills from spring, DebbiLyn seconded the motion, all in favor
- Typically in the past Booster Club has paid for Coaches to go to clinics, we pay for registration only. It’s \$459 for all the Football coaches to go to a clinic in Concord.
- Peggy made a motion to pay for the registration fees for the Football coaches to attend the Glazier Clinic in Concord not to exceed \$460, Glenn Seconded the motion, all in favor – coaches get access to the videos as well
- We talked about putting some mats down in the gym, it will help when it rains, there are 4 entrances to the gym, they are \$189 each for 4x6 size mat
- Renee made a motion to approve 4 mats for the entrances to the gym, not to exceed \$1,000, Kevin seconded the motion, all in favor
- Mike showed us the first rendering of the new website, he will send us the link to access it
